Our new printers are on their way and will be ready for use by the end of March. We are working with local telecommunications agencies to address our internet accessibility challenges.

You replaced our computer lab – with 15 computers over a decade old and older dot matrix printers – with these gifts that will better equip the men and women studying at ACC. When they graduate they will be able to use these laptops as leaders, preachers, and counselors throughout Africa.



My wife name is Linah Cheptoo and my child is Praise Chesebe



I want to express my sincere gratitude to all dearest friends of ACC. I am one of the students who benefited from the laptop computers you gave.


I am now able to do my school work anytime. My learning in the college has been made easier.










My name is Kirui Roberts




